With varied levels of difficulty and widths between trees, there are glades for most rider levels

New: SnowBiking! BCSC did this in Vail a few years ago and had a blast! Now SnowBikes are

permitted on all terrain and lifts of the Steamboat Ski Area with the exception of runs designated

as "Terrain Park" (Denoted by on-site signage and fencing). Participants must attend a Steam-

boat Snowbike lesson or show proof of previous class attendance at one of the participating

Colorado SnowBike Passport resorts. Rentals run from one hour to half day or full day rental.

We 'II definitely have a group snow bike day!

### with Beach Cities & Slope Surfers

Why drive? Why drive when instead you can sit back on the bus, have a beer and so-cialize with friends, watch a movie or take a nap. So forget that long exhausting drive home after skiing all day. I bring my pillow on the bus and nap on the Sunday ride home – then I am rested on Monday morning!

There are six remaining trips this season. Spaces are still available, but not for long. Send in your trip form and check now to reserve your spot.

2-Day Trips are \$240: Our 2 Day Mammoth Mountain trips are by deluxe motor coach, departing on Friday evening at 5:30pm sharp from the NG parking lot in Redondo Beach. Lancaster pick ups are available. We depart Mammoth Mountain at 4:30pm on Sunday. The trip price includes 2 nights lodging (at Chateau De Montagne townhomes – 3 or 4 bedroom units, no lofts!), bus ride, munchies, beer, sodas & water on the bus, breakfast items, Saturday dinner (meat lasagna, vegetarian lasagna, garlic bread, salad and red wine) plus dinner (sandwich or pizza – depending on the trip leader) and sodas on the trip home. Bonus: the bus will take us to and from the main lodge each day! No waiting and squeezing onto the Red Line. There is a jacuzzi at the condo complex, so bring a suit and towel. Must be 21 or older.


